**I**

The OFCOM Ordinance of 26 May 2016 on telecommunication installations<sup>1</sup> is amended as follows:

**Art. 9a** Transitional provision

Mobile phones with certain technical characteristics and not the additional essential requirement (Article 7 (3) ILO) in the Annex 1, ch. 6, may continue to be placed on the market until 16 March 2022.
