

New Divisions created in TEC

New Divisions have been created in TEC to cater to changing work environment, emerging technologies, changing telecom trends and enhanced role entrusted upon TEC.

1. Convergence & Broadcasting (C & B) Division

TRAI has recently designated TEC as Testing and Certification agency for Conditional Access System (CAS) & Subscriber Management System (SMS). The C&B Division has been created to handle matters related to overall administration of CAS and SMS and Test Schedule and Test Procedures thereof.

2. Industry Coordination (IC) Division

The IC Division is created to handle matters related to industry issues/ grievances and pilot trials of new upcoming technologies.

3. Telecom Skill Development (TSD) Division

The TSD Division is created to facilitate manpower training for MTCTE, students training in telecom sector, etc.

4. TBT Enquiry Point & Indigenous Manufacturing Promotion Division

The Government of India, Ministry of Commerce has designated Telecom Engineering Centre (TEC) as the WTO-TBT Enquiry Point under the Agreement on Technical Barriers to Trade of the World Trade Organization (WTO) to answer all reasonable inquiries from other members and interested parties concerning standards, technical regulations and conformity assessment procedures related to telecom sector.

Also, Ministry of Communications is the Nodal Ministry for implementation of Telecom Products Notifications issued in furtherance of Public Procurement Preference to Make in India (PPP-MII) Order 2017.

This is the Nodal Division for WTO-TBT Enquiry Point and PPP-MII Order for Telecom products and services.
